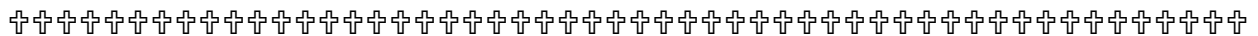

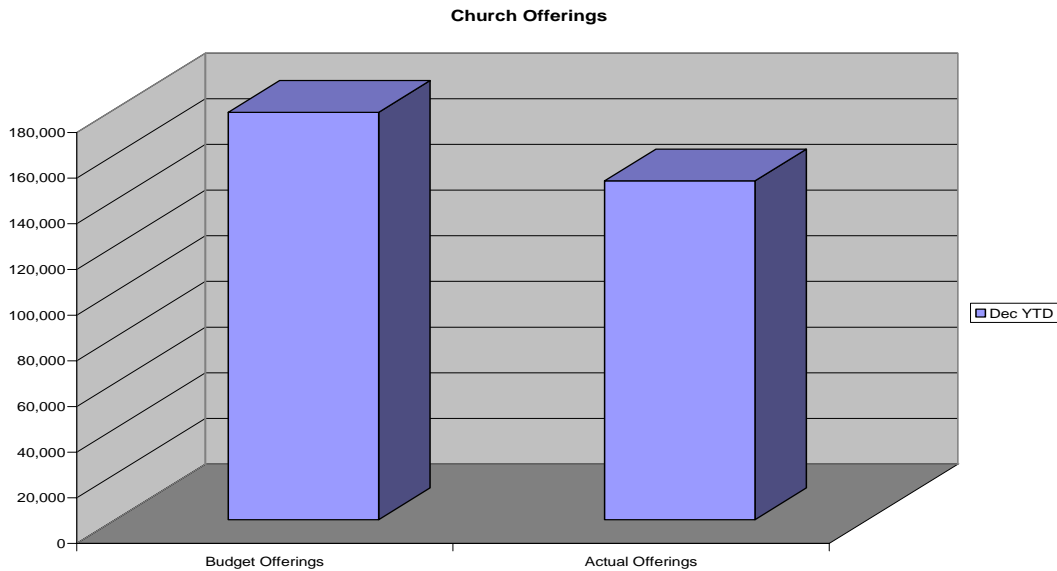

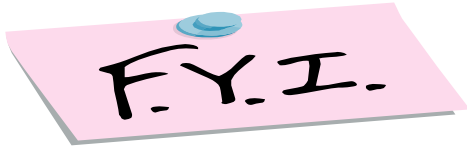

### **Cartridges for Cash**

#### **Attention All Parents!**

Bring in your empty OEM inkjet cartridges (placed in the original box that you would have thrown away to keep it safe from spills and damages, or a Ziploc bag) to the school. (Note: Epson cartridges cannot be recycled – they don't have a print head)

#### **Save up to 80% on cartridges while raising more funds for the school!**

InkSmile.com allows consumers to save money on over priced cartridges and they have a 5% Rebate Program where consumers can have 5% of their purchases donated to the school. This will help us raise funds for the school and its students.

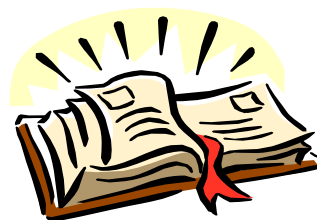
