Pilgrim Congregational Meeting Minutes from December 7, 2008

The special congregational call meeting for the purpose of calling an ELA director started at 9:50 a.m. on December 7, 2008.

President Cory Bandelin called the meeting to order.

Pastor Pete offered up a prayer.

There was a call for new members to sign in. Silas McAghon and his family were welcomed to the Pilgrim family. Experiential Learning for ALL (ELA) – 3 year pilot study program – Directors' Call

Motion:

Pilgrim extends a call for the Director's position for the new 3-year pilot study program of Experiential Learning for ALL (ELA). This call would be extended at a special call meeting on Sunday, November 23rd or November 30th at Pilgrim. The funding for this 3-year position (salary and health insurance) is to come from outside of the Pilgrim budget through secured grants and future grants, individual donations, consultant and other program fees, and matching funds. All salary and health benefit costs and all program contributions and fees will be handled through an already established ELA account under the auspices of the Twin Cities Chapter of WELS Kingdom Workers.

[The \$15,000.00 housing down payment loan will be made available to the Director, pending available funding from Pilgrim. The asked for costs for this program from Pilgrim would be WELS pension \$1,684 per year, continuing education reimbursement per current policy, assistance with moving expenses (if possible), and WELS Teacher's Conference dues and costs each year.]

Some program fees and the like may be passed along to families and involved participants in ELA. At the end of the 3-year pilot study, the position and program will be reevaluated.

Discussion

- Walt Zimmermann: Noted the new model of education this would bring. And that funding has been raised and commitment is there. Noted becoming leaders in education and a model for others
- Cory: Highlighted funding schedule (pg. 4) account is already about \$59,000.000. Pilgrim is \$5000 ahead due to loaning money to WELS kingdom workers account for this program,
- Bob Helmen: Will the foundation be evaluated year by year? Why not the money all up front?
- Cory: Not called out. There will obviously be constant reviews. Funders keep funds in investing
- Doug Kelm: Consider \$15,000 housing loan, Pilgrim is not capable
- John Martin: motion to strike \$15,000 housing and moving expenses.
- Aaron Robinson: Surplus could it be used?
- Bob Florin: Pilgrim is not financially capable
- Pastor Pete, Not Pilgrim accounts. Our participation is to add pension and use services
- Motion passed to strike bracketed info in motion.
- Cory: Called attention to call list. Noted biography of Luke Hartzell and 4 other candidates
- Bob Helmen: Motion to strike paper ballot for candidate's unanimous vote for Luke Hartzell.
- Motion seconded and passed at 10:25 am
- Closing prayer by Pastor Pete at 10:26

My cup runneth over = That's Abundance!


Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life = That's Blessing!

Congregations respond to Year of Jubilee

Congregations from across the synod have begun submitting Year of Jubilee offerings now that the dates targeted for the main celebration have passed. The Ministry of Christian Giving is marking the first million dollar milestone. To date, congregations and individuals have offered \$1.13 million.

The Ministry of Christian Giving scheduled the main thrust of Year of Jubilee to culminate Dec. 14, and offerings are coming in on a daily basis. Some congregations have chosen to wait to observe the celebration until after the new year begins.

The Year of Jubilee offering was authorized by the 2007 synod convention to reduce or eliminate the synod's \$22.4 million dollar debt and free up as much as \$2.7 million a year in debt payments for other ministry.

For congregations that have not yet participated, <u>information</u> and <u>resources</u> are available online. Individuals can also make <u>gifts online</u>. Gifts will be collected through July and then presented to the 2009 synod convention in Saginaw, Mich.
